



Terms and Conditions of Acceptance

Please read this document carefully.

Your offer of admission to Harvard Divinity School is contingent upon satisfying the conditions listed below

1. All acceptances to Harvard Divinity School are contingent upon satisfactory completion of any courses and degree programs in progress.
 - You are responsible for satisfying any unfinished requirements prior to matriculation; no exceptions can be made.
 - If you are currently an undergraduate student, you must complete all bachelor degree requirements before matriculating at Harvard Divinity School.
 - If you are currently enrolled in a graduate program, you must complete all advanced degree requirements prior to matriculation.
2. You must send updated official transcripts from each college or university you have attended –even if those course credits were transferred to another school – to the HDS Office of Admissions. All final transcripts must be on file no later than **August 1, 2013**.
 - If your application was processed with unofficial transcripts and/or English translations, you must provide us with official final transcripts, with official English translations (if applicable) by **July 1, 2013**.
 - The Final Transcript from your Primary undergraduate or graduate institution must show that your degree has been conferred.
3. If legal or criminal proceedings are filed against you prior to matriculation, or if you are the recipient of any institutional disciplinary action, it is your responsibility to inform the HDS Office of Admissions immediately.
4. In order to reserve your position at Harvard Divinity School, you must indicate your intention to enroll by completing the online response form and providing your enrollment deposit by the response deadline.
 - You are free to withdraw from the incoming class at any time.
 - Your enrollment deposit is non-refundable.
 - Out of fairness to waitlisted candidates, you should promptly decline your offer if you are certain that you will not attend.
